

GSOM - Bible School

Panoramic overview of the Bible

This module takes you beyond the surface of familiar Bible stories into the revelation, history, and divine context behind each book.

Students explore every book of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation as a panoramic unveiling of God's redemptive plan. You will discover the background, audience, authorship, and prophetic thread that runs through every page, connecting Scripture to the heart of Christ and the unfolding story of humanity.

Each session reveals how the Old and New Testaments mirror one another, how divine patterns are woven across centuries, and how every book contributes to the ultimate revelation of Jesus Christ. This is not a Sunday school retelling, but a dynamic, revelatory exploration that will forever reshape the way you read the Word.

Designed to deepen both understanding and spiritual insight, this module equips you to interpret Scripture through revelation.

MODULE 1

Systematic Theology (Revelation of God)

This module forms the theological backbone of the GSOM curriculum, revealing the divine order, structure, and revelation behind God's nature and His Word. Students are guided through the foundational doctrines of the Christian faith, exploring the character of God, the mystery of the Godhead, and the operation of the Holy Spirit. It provides a panoramic understanding of Scripture's unity, from creation to redemption, and how every doctrine interlocks to form the constitution of divine truth.

Through this journey, students will not only gain sound biblical understanding but will also encounter the depth of God's revelation, learning to think, interpret, and speak from a place of spiritual clarity and theological conviction.

MODULE 2

The Prolegomenon to Christology and Eschatology

This module unfolds two of the most profound dimensions of Scripture: the revelation of Christ and the mysteries of the end times. It begins with a deep exploration of Christology, unveiling Jesus both in His humanity and divinity, the Man who walked among men and the Messiah who revealed the nature of God. Students gain insight into how Christ bridges heaven and earth, embodying perfect obedience, redemption, and divine revelation.

The second half delves into Eschatology, the study of last things, offering a prophetic and scriptural understanding of the end-time timeline. Learners will journey through the Book of Daniel, the rise of the Antichrist, the rapture, tribulation, and the millennial reign, discovering how eternity intersects with time and how God's redemptive plan culminates in the restoration of all things.

This module equips students with both doctrinal understanding and prophetic discernment, enabling them to read the signs of the times through the lens of Christ's victory and eternal purpose.

MODULE 3

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Panoramic Spectrum of Leadership

This module explores the divine architecture of leadership, how God shapes, refines, and empowers individuals to carry influence with excellence and integrity. Students are taken beyond traditional leadership principles into the spiritual and emotional dimensions that form enduring leaders in ministry and life. Through a study of Christian leadership dynamics, learners discover what it means to lead with conviction, courage, and vision that cannot be broken by adversity. The lessons on Emotional Intelligence reveal how the emotional and spiritual realms intertwine, unlocking the discipline, focus, and character needed to lead from a place of maturity and excellence.

The journey continues in The Making of a Leader, where students learn the principles of servanthood, second-chair leadership, and group dynamics. This module develops leaders who are not driven by ambition, but by assignment, those who lead with empathy, clarity, and the wisdom of the Spirit.

MODULE 4

Revival of Church Dispensations Throughout History

From the fires of the early Church to the great awakenings and the 20th-century outpourings, this module highlights how God continually breathes new life into His people.

More than a historical survey, it is a prophetic reflection on how the same Spirit that stirred revival through history is now calling the modern Church to awaken again with purpose, purity, and power.

MODULE 5

How to Fulfill Your Personal Ministry

Its objective is to challenge you to walk worthy of the call of God and to equip you with the required theological and practical knowledge and skills.

The primary emphasis will be placed on the science and art of leading people, understanding the underlying purposes and principles of ministry, acquiring shepherding skills, the art of warfare, the laws that govern ministry, etc.

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The Secret Lives Of Peter, Paul, James, John & Thomas
